



HOLY HOURS OF ADORATION

What is the difference between 'My Visit with Jesus' and My Holy Hour of Adoration?

Boys and Girls,

The difference is just what it says. When you 'Visit' Jesus you step into your Church or Chapel and stay for maybe 5 or 10 minutes. Just let Jesus know that you are thinking of Him and wanted to give Him your love!

When you come to 'Adore Jesus' then you stay a little longer, and you pray 'prayers of reparation' to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. This means you love Jesus so much that you want to 'repair' His broken Heart for others who pay no attention to Him in the Blessed Sacrament, or don't even stop to think of Him.

When the Angel of Peace appeared to the Little Shepherds of Fatima, he not only taught them about sacrifices, but also 'how to adore Jesus' and about special prayers of 'reparation.'

Below are prayers that the Angel taught the children, and they are meant for you and all the children of the world.

Ask your teachers and parents to take you into your Parish Church or Chapel to Adore Jesus and to make Reparation to Jesus. He will be so happy that you came to adore Him! This shows Jesus your great Faith and Love for Him.

PARDON PRAYER

"My God, I Believe, I Adore, I Hope
and I Love You!

I ask PARDON of You for those
Who Do Not Believe, Do Not Adore,
Do Not Hope and Do Not Love You!"

3 times or as many times as you wish

Prayer of Reparation to Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament

"Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit,
I Adore You Profoundly, and I offer You the
Most Precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of
Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the

world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges
and indifference with which He Himself is offended.

And, through the infinite merits of
His Most Sacred Heart,
and the Immaculate Heart of Mary,
I beg of You the Conversion of Poor Sinners."
