WORLD MISSION ROSARY






The 1st Luminous Mystery: The Baptism of the Lord


The 2nd Luminous Mystery: The Wedding at Cana

The 3rd Luminous Mystery:


The Proclamation of the Kingdom & the Call to Conversion A Fruit of this Mystery is a desire for the salvation of souls


The 4th Luminous Mystery: The Transfiguration A Fruit of this mystery is hope of Heaven's Glory

3. ALL: (3 times)

O Most Holy Trinity, I adore You! My God, My God, I love You in the Most Blessed Sacrament!

And thanks to all of you children and young people who have joined us through the media. It is a wonderful and powerful thing for all of us, young and old, on every continent to be joined together in prayer through this Network. Time permitting, the **celebrant offers some words on Fatima, etc.** at this time. If so, all are seated.

And then he invites all to pray the **Prayer for the Consecration of the Family** saying:

Let us conclude our prayers, fathers and mothers, young people and children, by making an act of consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Never permit any of my family to stray from the true faith.

For any family member who has strayed,
I beseech you to bind up the wounds, lift up the fallen,
restore and keep each of our loved ones in grace.
