

Prayers of the Angel of Peace

Prayers taught by Our Lady

THE PARDON PRAYER

The angel who appeared to the children called himself the Angel of Peace and the Angel of Portugal. He taught them the following prayer:

“My God, I believe, I adore, I hope, and I love Thee! I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love Thee.”

THE PRAYER OF EUCHARISTIC REPARATION TAUGHT BY THE ANGEL OF PEACE

On one occasion, the three children saw the angel prostrate before a host and chalice that hung in the air. Worshipping the Eucharist, the angel prayed,

“Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit- I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges, and indifferences whereby He is offended. And through the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of Thee the conversion of poor sinners.”

***Angel of Peace at Fatima**

Told the three shepherd children to “make everything you do a sacrifice and offer them to God this will bring peace to your country.”

THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

During the initial apparition on **May 13, 1917**, Our Lady bathed the children in light, and they were "moved by an interior impulse that was ... communicated to [them]", so they said this prayer.

O most Holy Trinity, I adore You! My God, my God, I love You in the most Blessed Sacrament!

THE SACRIFICE PRAYER – Our Lady at Fatima

The Blessed Mother taught the children to offer all their personal sacrifices to God by praying,

“Oh my Jesus, I offer this for the love of Thee, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.”

THE ROSARY DECADE PRAYER – Our Lady at Fatima

On July 13th, 1917, Our Lady taught the following prayer and asked the little shepherds to pray it at the end of each decade of the Rosary.

Oh, My Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy.
